

WANT TO TAKE ON AN APPRENTICE AND GET £2,500 WORTH OF FUNDING?

If you take on a 16 – 17 year old apprentice through Accrington and Rossendale College before April 2010 you may be eligible for funding of up to £2,500.

How does it work?

The National Apprenticeship Service Golden Hello payment has been introduced to help support up to 5,000 employers that would like to employ an apprentice, with grants of £2,500.

If you commit to taking on a new or additional apprentice in paid employment (the minimum apprenticeship wage requirement that you will be expected to pay is £95 per week) for the duration of their training with Accrington & Rossendale College, you may be eligible for a £2,500 bonus which will subsidise the wage requirements.

We offer apprenticeships in most industries including most areas of construction and technology, hair and beauty, hospitality and catering, accounting, business and administration, IT, child care, customer service, retail, travel and tourism, sport, and much more.
